

2021, 8th grade confirmation final project.

As part of the 8th grade requirements for confirmation, each student is required to complete a final project. This project was broken into different stages:

First, each student is to choose a favorite Bible passage and explain in 2 paragraphs why it is their favorite or what special meaning it holds for them. This is due to pastor Steve NO LATER than Sunday November 15, 2020.

Second, each student will complete a written essay that answers this 2 part question: What do I believe about God (2 paragraphs at least) and how does what I believe effect how I live my life (2 paragraphs at least).

Each student must write their own essay, but should receive guidance from their parents/grandparents/mentors/teachers... The first rough draft is due to Pastor Steve by Sunday Jan. 31, 2021. Pastor Steve will then review each essay and work with each student to make sure it answers the questions, and that it is written in a way that will be easy to read to the congregation during a worship service leading up to Confirmation Day. The final approved typed draft needs to be to by pastor by Sunday March 7, 2021.

Each student will read their essay on one of the assigned Sunday mornings during the regular worship service at 9am. The Sundays are April 11, 18, 25, May 2, 19. Or we can record them reading and play them in the large screen, during the assigned service. If you have a preference, please let Pastor Steve know otherwise it will be assigned.

Confirmation service is Sunday May 16 at 10:30am.

Confirmation Day Schedule:

- 8am Regular worship service. All of the students being confirmed are required to arrive at this service by 8:45 at the latest to be able to greet the congregation after the service.
- 9:00 Cake Reception, hosted by 7th grade class
- 9:30 Confirmands will get their robes, flowers and stoles on for their pictures.
- 10:25 Students will line up in the narthex to process into the sanctuary.
- 10:30 (or close thereafter) Worship begins
